## Step-By-Step Guide to GMRS Licensing

**Step 1:** Visit <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do> to register a new username

**Step 2:** Check your email address to confirm your registration

**Step 3:** Re-visit <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do> and enter your newly registered username & password

**Step 4:** Select “Register New FRN” and complete prompts.

Select “Register New FRN. Register and Receive a new FRN (including Commercial/Non-Commercial Broadcast Ownership Reporting Restricted Use FRN)”

**Step 5:** Upon completion/confirmation, **SAVE** the 10-digit FRN number assigned to your username account.

**Step 6:** Re-visit <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do> and login again. Select “Associate Username to FRN”

“ZA - General Mobile Radio (GMRS)” from the drop-down menu
